
















Department of the Air Force (DAF) Open Topic Solicitation


Topics are truly "open" and agnostic of industry, technology, or problem area.

We are seeking...


- Innovative, <u>dual-use</u> tech solutions (i.e. applicable to defense and non-defense)
- Clear potential to solve a <u>DAF mission need</u> (USAF, USSF)
- Capability to prototype under an <u>accelerated schedule</u>
- Ability to scale and grow the industrial base for defense
- Commitment from an empowered <u>DAF end-user and customer</u>
- Applied R/R&D efforts rather than "front-end" or basic research

Upcoming Space Open Topic Cycles

Phase I solicitations include SBIR and STTR / D2P2 solicitations include SBIR only




Solicitations vs. Topics*

Evaluation Rules

A business may only submit <u>one</u> proposal per <u>solicitation</u>.

Customer memorandum is required

All proposals must be prepared and submitted through the Department of Defense (DOD) SBIR/STTR Innovation Portal (DSIP)

Phase I-Like Feasibility Study

- Direct to Phase II (D2P2) awards are granted to continue the research and development (R&D) from prior non-SBIR research and feasibility studies, aka 'Phase I-like effort'.
- Proposals should demonstrate sufficient technical progress or problem-solving results to warrant more extensive Research Development Test and Evaluation (RDT&E) via a comprehensive, detailed description of previous efforts.
- Feasibility documentation cannot be based upon or logically extend from any prior or ongoing federally funded SBIR or STTR work.

What is Research or Research & Development (R/RD)?

- A systematic study directed toward greater knowledge or understanding of the subject studied
- 2. A systematic study directed specifically toward applying knowledge and innovation to meet a recognized but unmet need
- A systematic application of knowledge and innovation toward the production of useful materials, devices, and systems or methods, including design, development, and improvement of prototypes and new processes to meet specific requirements

Includes **ALL** fields (physical sciences, engineering, etc.)

Why Does R/R&D Matter to SBIR/STTR Applicants?

SBIR/STTR programs are funded by RDT&E appropriations. Use of these funds is governed by federal financial law. Therefore, proposed projects must meet certain definitions and requirements to be eligible for SBIR/STTR funding.



R/R&D concerning COTS & NDIs

Items purchased directly from a commercial source that can be utilized without alteration through design and development, or without modification, are <u>commercial off-the-shelf (COTS)</u> or <u>nondevelopmental items (NDI)</u>. This includes ready-to-use software, training services, and ready-to-use products.

COTS and NDIs by themselves are not suitable for SBIR/STTR funding.

HOWEVER

There **may** be exceptions if:

- The end item requires design and development in order to accept the COTS/NDI
- The COTS/NDI are required for RDT&E test purposes
- The proposal involves <u>significant</u> modification of COTS/NDI
 - To satisfy user requirements
 - Develop a capability

Overall R/R&D Suggestions

- Demonstrate completion of R/R&D through means not solely based on previous efforts under the SBIR/STTR Programs to establish Phase II proposal feasibility based on criteria provided in the D2P2 topic descriptions
- Feasibility documentation cannot be based upon or logically extend from any prior or ongoing federally funded SBIR or STTR work.
- Ensure your proposal is <u>explicit</u> in explaining the RDT&E work you will be accomplishing
- Ensure your proposal does not lump R&D costs under licensing to provide clarity to the actual costs

D2P2 Proposal Structure

- Vol 1: Proposal Cover Sheet (SAM, UEI, CAGE, Abstract, etc)
 - Addressed in Part I, Commercial Solutions Opening Preface
- Vol 2: Technical Volume
 - Mandatory white paper, 15 page maximum, excluding table of contents and glossary (pages in excess NOT reviewed)
 - Non-Proprietary Work Plan and Commercialization Plan Outline
- Vol 3: Cost Volume
 - System formatted inputs
- Vol 4: Company Commercialization Report (CCR)
 - Follow solicitation instructions for Volume 4
 - o CCR information is maintained and report is generated via sbir.gov
 - o CCR is uploaded to DSIP as part of the proposal submission process, as applicable

D2P2 Proposal Structure (Cont'd)

- Vol 5: Supporting Documents
 - MANDATORY customer memorandum (CM) on required template**



- TRI Attachment 3: Regulatory Compliance Initial Safety Assessment Form
- Always refer back to the solicitation for required attachments
- Vol 6: Fraud, Waste, and Abuse Training
- Vol 7: Disclosures of Foreign Affiliations or Relationship to Foreign Countries
 - The corporate official cannot certify and submit the full proposal until Volume VII webform is fully completed and submitted.

IMPORTANT:

Proposals that do not include properly prepared Attachments 3 and Vol 7 will also be deemed noncompliant and will not receive an evaluation.

Customer Memorandum

Signatures



Customer/End-user may be from same organization, but must not be the same person.

- 3 CAC-enabled, digital signatures required (Customer, End-User, & TPOC) on a single memorandum Your proposal is
- Must be government (either Military or Civilian)
- FFRDC/Support contractors **MAY NOT SIGN**
- Customer or end-user may be non-DAF member from a DoD joint org
- TPOC MUST be a DAF (USAF or USSF) member in all cases

Customer Memorandum Potential Grounds For Disqualification



Your proposal is limited to a <u>single</u> customer memorandum with <u>three digital</u>, CAC-enabled signatures

- Multiple memorandums with individual signatures are <u>NOT</u> accepted and will result in disqualification
- Scans, photos, and image reproductions of the form are <u>NOT</u> accepted as they do not allow for digital signature verification
- Avoid using Adobe Distiller to complete or modify the form we suggest using Adobe Acrobat to mitigate data corruption issues

Failure to comply with these requirements may be grounds for disqualification.

General Advice Submission Requirements

- All eligible offerors must be qualifying, registered small businesses in SAM.gov prior to award, we suggest registering early to avoid delays!
- This solicitation is for **Direct-to-Phase II only**
 - Max contract terms of \$1.25M, 21 months period of performance
- Complete proposals must be submitted via the Defense SBIR/STTR Innovation Portal (DSIP)
 - o Proposals cannot be pre-read or recommended for submission
 - No email or other non-DSIP submissions will be received.
- Must be RDT&E activities
 - Not services or procurement
- Fraud, Waste, and Abuse training Volume 6
 - Must be completed by one DSIP firm user with read/write access (proposal owner, corporate official, or firm admin) on behalf of the firm
- Proposals that do not meet submission requirements will not be accepted

General Advice Cont.

Common Causes for Non-Selection

- Exceeding Cost or Duration Limits \$1.25M and 21 months max
- <u>SAM.gov Registration</u> firms must have an active registration, we suggest registering early to avoid delays!
- <u>Missing Documentation</u> all required volumes and attachments must be included per the solicitation
 - Invalid or missing Customer Memo
 - Must have THREE valid signatures
 - Must use the most recent version that includes the current solicitation on the header
 - Unsigned or missing Volume VII: Disclosures of Foreign Affiliations or Relationships to Foreign Countries
 - Missing or incomplete Attachment 3: Regulatory Compliance Initial Safety Assessment

Multiple Submissions

- A small business concern may only submit one proposal under each solicitation
- A small business concern is prohibited from submitting a proposal under both topics (i.e. submit to both the AF and SF topics of a single D2P2 SBIR solicitation)
- If more than one proposal from a small business concern is received for a single solicitation, only the most recent proposal to be certified and submitted prior to the submission deadline will be eligible for evaluation

General Advice Cont.

Common Causes for Non-Selection

- Minimum Performance Percentage of Work Not allocated properly
 - Small business must perform 50% or more of the work (SBIR)
- R/R&D Work, as proposed, does not meet the definition of R/R&D required for funding
 - Proposed work is not R/R&D
- Data Rights Assertions
 - Proposal claims data rights assertions without including a *Data Rights* Assertions table (as found in DFARS 252.227-7017) in Volume V, Supporting
 Documents, of the proposal.

General Advice cont.

Common Proposal Issues

- Not addressing solicitation requirements, particularly evaluation criteria (refer to CSO solicitation covering Selection Methodology and Evaluation Criteria)
- Unclear proposed benefit to the government customer (see solicitation: Table 1: Technical Volume Content Description)
- Inconsistent milestones/timelines and proposal not matching Customer Memorandum (see solicitation: Table 2: Non-Proprietary Phase II Work Plan Outline)
- COTS/Software licenses appropriateness for proposed effort (see solicitation
